Trenton June 9th 1870

At a meeting of The A Class of the State Normal School of New Jersey, held June 6, 1870, the house was called to order by Wife Sarah ~ Hill, and said lady was appointed chairman of The meeting, after which the class proved to adopt the following resolutions.

1st Resolved that the graduating class of The State Normal School of New Jersey for the term ending June 30, 1870 to have a reunion.

 $2^{\rm nd}$ Resolution. Resolved that such reunion be held at the Continental Hotel in Philadelphia

3rd resolved that such reunion be held three years from the 8th of August 1870.

4th Resolved that said class extend a special invitation to teachers of said class to attend such reunion.

5th Resolved that a Secretary and Assistant Secretary be appointed and that each member of said class write to said Secretary or Assistant Secretary, in case The duty of the office fall to her, once a year, telling their whereabouts etc.

A motion was then made that the class proceed to elect a Secretary and Assiatant Secretary and Miss Rosalie A. Collins being just in nomination for Secretary was elected by a unanimous vote, and Miss Cornelia Hatchett being put on nomination also elected by a unanimous vote.

After which the meeting adjourned.
