The Assembly of God Church in the town of Corydon, Iowa, was organized by Rev. Everett Hollingshead of Chariton, Ia., before the year of 1930. In book 30, page 411 in the Wayne County Records office we find a deed made by R.A. Richardson et al to the Assembly of God to Pentecostal Church of God trustees or their successors. R.A. Richardson - J. Earl Davison and Chas. Hand. Thus the Assembly of God Church

was in existence before that time. There must have been some difference of opinion which caused a division in the church.

The Assembly of God Church then purchased a plot of ground in North Corydon along highway No. 14, built a small church where they worshiped according to their belief.

The first Pastor was, Rev. Everett Hollingshead.
