Isaac N. Bedford



Isaac N. Bedford (Bradford) (b. abt 1838), son of Thomas Bedford and Matilda, married 27 Nov 1861 Anna M. Leighton (b. abt 1838) of Rodney, Jefferson Co., MS.

He enlisted in the 33rd Miss. Inf., Co. D, 1 Apr 1862, in Franklin Co., MS. From 1 Apr to 1 Aug of that year, he served at Corporal.

Isaac and Anna appear together on the Mississippi census records for 1870 Franklin Co., and that of the 1880, 1890, and 1910 Jefferson Co.

Isaac N. Bedford also appears on the 1890 "Special Schedule.—Surviving Soldiers, Sailors, and Marines, and Widows, etc." form.

The 1920 census for Jefferson Co., MS, shows a widower, L. N. Bedford (should be I. N. Bedford), age 82, a farmer, living with his married daughter Ollie J. Millsopps, age 43. This is daughter Olive J., born about 1876.

His marker reads,
